B 2020.17493: TUR-B (urinary bladder): a fraction of a non-invasive papillary urothelial carcinoma (low-grade according to WHO 2016, G2). Separate fragment with tumor-free smooth (detrusor) musculature. No fraction of tumor distal urothelium.

TNM staging classification (8th edition): pTa, low grade.
